**ORDER**

**UPON** the appellant's letter dated September 29, 2022 providing further information as to procedural matters and requesting that the appeal continue to be held in abeyance until 45 days following the Canadian Human Rights Tribunal's decision with respect to a settlement agreement;

**AND UPON** considering the previous orders of this Court dated November 16, 2021, January 13, 2022, April 26, 2022 and May 24, 2022;

**AND UPON** considering the interests of justice, including that the appeal should not be held in abeyance indefinitely;

**THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:**

1. The appeal will continue to be held in abeyance until the earliest of January 30, 2023 and the date 45 days following the release of the Canadian Human Rights Tribunal's decision on the approval motion.
2. The parties shall inform the Court as to the status of the matter on or before January 30, 2023.
