I write to you today on behalf of the Assembly of First Nations (AFN) further to Panel's Direction dated August 9, 2022 regarding the motion by the Federation of Sovereign Indigenous Nations (FSIN) to intervene in AFN's motion on compensation.

The AFN does not consent to nor oppose the intervention of FSIN. However, should FSIN be granted intervener status, the AFN submits that such intervention be limited to making written submissions (and oral submissions should this motion proceed by way of hearing) on this single motion only regarding the Final Settlement Agreement on Compensation.
